The intern will be trained on and gain experience in:

In addition to the items listed above, you'll gain experience in project management using team collaboration software, customer data management, graphics creation for online content, and booth marketing events among other things.

THE OPPORTUNITY

This is an educational (unpaid) internship beginning in April or May 2019 (depending on the intern's availability) and ending in August 2019. I can work with just about any schedule. The amount of time you work will depend on how quickly you learn and complete tasks, but there is a lot of flexibility here for the right person.

You will have access to my office/massage studio and we'll occasionally meet at my home office. However, assuming that you have a laptop, the location of the work is not important and working from home is an option. You will need to have access to your own computer or laptop as well as reliable internet and transportation for meetings, events, and networking.

Other requirements include computer literacy and internet research skills. Knowledge of social media is helpful but not required. A desire to learn and grow skills that you can carry over to your future employment is a must as well as excellent communication skills so that we're always on the same page.

Additionally, I have extensive experience in Human Resources and the hiring process/practices of other businesses. I have previously worked as a job coach helping people create stellar resumes that increase

their chances of getting hired as well as offering interview coaching. I previously taught executives how to complete successful employment interviews and tips on hiring decisions.
